

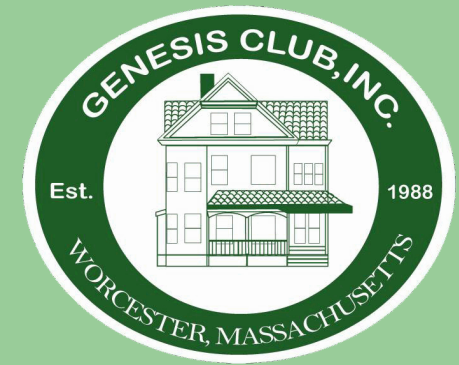
Partnership for Recovery

Our Mission

The Genesis Club was established in 1988 to assist individuals with a mental illness to obtain employment, education, housing, wellness, and friendships. Members and staff work together in all aspects of the club including:

- preparing meals
- landscaping
- policy making
- general maintenance
- writing grants
- reception
- training other clubhouses

Genesis Club membership is open to anyone who has a diagnosis of a mental illness. The clubhouse provides a place of hope, dignity, and friendship.

There are seven different work units and Members choose how they utilize the Clubhouse:

- Membership Services
- Business and Research
- Food Services
- Career Development
- Snack Shop, Social, Maintenance
- Training and Development
- Housing

Programs & Supports

Education– Genesis Club supports members who are looking for opportunities to pursue goals in higher education by obtaining a high school equivalency diploma and attending college. Last year, with the support of Genesis, we saw 54 members enrolled in post secondary education.

Employment – There are three different employment programs offered at the clubhouse: Transitional Employment, Supported Employment, and Independent Employment. This program allows members the opportunity to work at real jobs, earn competitive wages, and to fulfill employment goals. Last year, Genesis Club had 146 members return to work and earn \$1,146,081.29.

Housing– Genesis Club provides members the opportunity to acquire affordable and comfortable housing. We support our members in being good neighbors and tenants and to live as citizens in their community.
