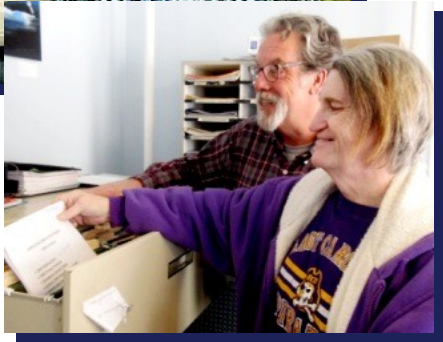
Clubhouses are employment & recovery centers that offer opportunities for members to reach their full potential.

OUR MISSION

Genesis Club was established in 1988 to assist individuals with a mental illness to succeed in employment, education, housing, wellness, and friendships.

Membership is open to adults with a diagnosis of a mental illness. The clubhouse provides a place of hope, dignity, friendship and recovery.

There is no charge for membership.



A key part of Genesis Club is the partnership between members and staff. Members and staff work together in all aspects of the club. Work is organized into 6 different units, and members choose the unit(s) they would like to participate.

UNITS

- **Membership Services:** Tours, orientation, outreach to hospitals, community visits, clerical and computer work.
- **Business and Research:** Main switchboard, tracking statistics, typing, clerical duties, bulk mailings, newsletter publication and fiscal responsibilities.
- **Food Services:** Preparing and serving meals, ordering food and supplies, and kitchen clean up and equipment maintenance.
- **Career Development:** Developing a full array of various employment and education opportunities in the community.
- **Environmental and Facilities:** Cashier, counter work, shopping for supplies, landscaping, ground maintenance, general maintenance, and promoting wellness activities.
- **Training and Development:** Coordinating international training, fundraising, marketing, website and community awareness, event coordination, website and social media management, and grant writing.

OPPORTUNITIES

Education: Genesis Club supports members who are looking for opportunities to pursue their education goals. Last year, with the support of Genesis, we saw 78 members enrolled in post secondary education.



Employment: It is the cornerstone of Genesis Club. There are three types of support offered: Transitional Employment, Supported Employment, and Independent Employment. Last year, 187 members worked, earning \$1,600,041.14.

Housing: We support our members in being good neighbors and tenants. Genesis Club supports members to obtain, maintain, and improve their housing.

Wellness Initiatives: Opportunities to exercise together in structured and unstructured ways; A focus on healthy eating and nutrition education; tobacco reduction and cessation support and dual recovery anonymous meetings.
